MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) FOR CARTER COUNTY PARTICIPATION IN THE 2017-2018 CLASSROOM CONNECTIONS BY KENTUCKY POWER GRANT



This agreement is made between the Kentucky Educational Development Corporation (KEDC), 904 Rose Road, Ashland, KY 41102, and the Carter County Board of Education, 228 S Carol Malone Blvd, Carter, KY 41143.

Purpose, Terms and Period of Contract:

- 1. KEDC, an educational cooperative organized under the Kentucky Interlocal Cooperation Act, having secured a grant from the American Electric Power Foundation to provide virtual learning experiences for the 2018-2019 school year agrees to provide the following services to Carter County located in the Kentucky Power service area:
 - a. Training and support for 2-4 returning and or new GOAL participants within the district;
 - b. A stipend for each participant in the amount of \$1,000 paid quarterly;
 - c. Support and access to virtual educational experience providers and;
 - d. Support and access to specific services related the work (technology hardware, online services, and professional development).
- 2. Carter County agrees to:
 - a. Allow GOAL participants to attend 4 trainings at the KEDC Ashland (or Lexington) location;
 - b. Support GOAL participants in fulfilling grant responsibilities including providing substitute teachers as necessary;
 - c. Support sharing of learning with other staff;
 - d. Allow students to participate in virtual learning experiences under the supervision of GOAL participants;
 - e. Submit surveys or other related documents to show measurable growth; and
 - f. Support the work of the work of the grant by assisting KEDC and Kentucky Power in promoting how the grant has impacted learning in your district.
