Contractual Agreement for the partnership with Health First Bluegrass (FQHC) in
KDE's Improving Student Health and Academic achievement COVID 19

THIS agreement entered into on November 11, 2020 between the *Kentucky Educational Development Corporation* and Health First Bluegrass (a Federally Qualified Health Center) will enable the parties to collaborate in the creation of trainings, educational materials, resources, and videos highlighting best practices related to school re-entry surrounding COVID-19 guidance. Guidance will include resources identified by the National Association of School Nurses (NASN) and the National School-Based Health Alliance (NSBAC).

These newly developed resources will be disseminated to schools, districts, school nurses, local health departments, and FQHCs located throughout the state. The FQHC will collaborate with partners to provide professional development and technical assistance sessions. All resources will be shared on local, regional and state partner websites for encouraged use of appropriate practice in addressing students with chronic health conditions.

In consideration of these services and based on invoices, *KEDC* will pay Health First Bluegrass for services based on the budget below.
