



ROAD MAP (One Method)




ROAD MAP (Many Methods)






Blended Learning

Blended Learning is NOT.....Teacher Centered.... It is NOT replacing good teaching with technology



Teacher Centered



Blended Learning is a shift from a teacher centered classroom to a student centered classroom, where students become active and interactive learners.....



Instructional Challenges

In a Blended Learning classroom, the teacher may also serve as a facilitator who <u>LEADS</u> the learning of students, rather than the teacher who delivers the instruction.

6 most common models currently in use









Face to Face Driver

- Teacher still delivers majority of curriculum
- Online Learning is used on a "case-by-case basis"
- A Supplement to plug into a Lesson
- Taking projects beyond the classroom with Web 2.0
- Examples | google docs, edmodo, twitter, wordpress, prezi, animoto





- Students rotate on a fixed schedule between online learning and the traditional classroom
- Blends self-paced work online with face-to-face instruction
- Examples | Flipped Classroom, Technology stations in the classroom, Lab Rotation





Flex

- Relies on an online platform that delivers most of the curriculum to students
- May have small group instruction with teachers
- Majority of work is done online
- Model is used often for many dropout-recovery programs
- Example | Credit Recovery Online Programs





Online Lab

- Learning takes place on school campus in a computer lab
- Online teachers deliver curriculum on a online learning platform
- Teacher is not in the computer lab, but could be in another school or classroom
- Examples could include AP or Dual Credit Classes





Self-Blend

- Online curriculum platform
- Online Learning is always remote
- Students has access at any time and any location
- Students have the option on the combination of traditional classes and online classes
- Examples | Online College Course or Online Schools

- Both the online learning platform and the traditional teacher deliver content.
- Majority of work is done remotely, but face-to-face meetings take place.
- Most Engagement for Most Students, students can still have a choice on the face-to-face.
